INITIATION is the new series of evolutionary oil paintings by Kimberly Webber. The series features shamanic spirit animals and birds merging with archetypal figures. Non-profit organizations are linked to each painting and print image and a portion of the proceeds is being donated to the corresponding charity. There are a total of 24 original paintings in the series with the first 12 works opening at Lurie Gallery, 2736 S. La Cienega Blvd., Los Angeles, CA 90048, phone # 310-876-1780. The VIP Opening and book signing is February 2nd, 2017, 6 to 9 p.m. and the Grand Opening is Saturday February 4th, 2017, 6 to 9 p.m. A closing reception is scheduled for Thursday, February 23rd, 2017 from 6 to 8 p.m. There is a Taos Preview party December 30th, 2016 at Untitled Fine Art, 133 Kit Carson Road, Taos, NM 87571, 5 to 7 p.m.

The paintings further explore the artist's Asian and European fusion technique and the multiplicity of earth pigment layers. Pure lapis, mica, iron oxide, gold, copper and various pigments and minerals sourced from South America, Siberia, Italy, Egypt and Mesopotamia all transmit the intelligence of the earth. The technique is an innovative alchemical process rooted in ancient traditions from both Asia and Europe. Thousands-of-year old calligraphic and shamanic Daoist elements, rice paper, hand-made ink, resin and pitch are seamlessly blended with European Renaissance oil painting science and mystical Illuminated Manuscript traditions. The final surfaces are polished, translucent oil paintings that invite the viewer deep into their multidimensional worlds of organic abstraction, archetypal priestesses, forests and totemic medicine animals and birds. At once subtle and colossal, ancient and contemporary, gentle and powerful INITIATION features works that honor the natural world, medicine animals and the dignity and strength of the Divine Feminine spirit. An "initiation" is a new beginning, a rite of passage that each of us is being called to embark upon. Individually and collectively we are evolving out of paradigms that destroy the very systems that sustain all life. We are creating and embracing systems that revolve around renewable, sustainable and regenerative methods. We are letting go of the illusion of fear and scarcity and embodying love and the reality of sufficiency. We have the power to change. The animals and birds are messengers helping humanity to awaken to our inter-dependence; with each other, the planet and all life.

Endangered and vulnerable species are highlighted in the series, including lion, tiger, cheetah, black jaguar, wolf, butterfly, owl and falcon. The animals and birds have always carried frequencies of wisdom and medicine. They bring gifts of prophecy, healing and magic to humanity. Indigenous leader Chief Seattle of the Suquamish Tribe said "Whatever happens to the beast also happens to man. All things are connected." We have lost almost 58% of our wild species populations since 1970. It is time now to act. INITIATION calls the viewer and humanity into action through the archetypal images and their power to reach deep into the collective heart consciousness. The artist is donating part of the proceeds to organizations that are working to protect wild habitats and help our shared world heritage wild life recover and thrive.
